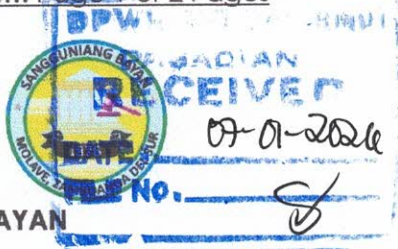

RESOLUTION NO. 12th-418-2026

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING ENGR. PABLO L. ESCUADRO, MPA, DISTRICT ENGINEER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH), 1ST DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE, RIZAL AVENUE BALANGASAN DISTRICT, PAGADIAN CITY TO CONDUCT AN IMMEDIATE TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT AND IMPLEMENT THE NECESSARY CORRECTIVE MEASURES ON THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM ALONG THE PETRON-SEAOIL SECTION OF THE NATIONAL ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MOLAVE, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, TO ADDRESS THE RECURRING PONDING OF RAINWATER AND ENSURE THE UNOBSTRUCTED FLOW OF SURFACE RUNOFF FOR THE PROTECTION OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND WELFARE.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, otherwise referred to as the General Welfare Clause, mandates local government units to promote the general welfare by ensuring the preservation of life and property, improving public safety, and maintaining infrastructure supportive of sustainable community development;

WHEREAS, during the by the Committee on Infrastructure and Community Development, the Committee noted the persistent accumulation and ponding of rainwater along the section of the national highway extending from PETRON to SEAOIL within the Municipality of Molave, particularly during periods of moderate to heavy rainfall, thereby creating inconvenience to motorists and pedestrians and posing potential risks to public safety;

WHEREAS, the Officer-in-Charge Municipal Engineer informed the Committee that the area previously had an existing drainage canal intended to serve as the natural outlet of stormwater; however, with the implementation of ongoing road improvement works undertaken by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), the existing drainage outlet appears to have been altered, obstructed, or rendered ineffective, resulting in the observed flooding and inadequate drainage in the area;

WHEREAS, considering that the affected roadway forms part of the national road network and falls under the administrative and technical jurisdiction of the Department of Public Works and Highways pursuant to Executive Order No. 124 (1987), it is appropriate that the concerned DPWH office conduct a comprehensive engineering assessment to determine the cause of the drainage deficiency and undertake the corresponding corrective interventions in accordance with applicable engineering standards;

WHEREAS, the immediate restoration of an effective drainage system is necessary not only to prevent recurring flooding and deterioration of the roadway but also to

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safeguard motorists, commuters, business establishments, and residents from avoidable hazards and property damage, especially during the rainy season;

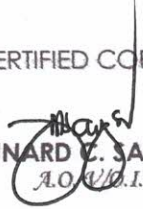
WHEREAS, that the DPWH is likewise respectfully requested to coordinate with the Municipal Government of Molave, through the Municipal Engineering Office, in the conduct of the assessment and in the formulation and implementation of appropriate engineering solutions to effectively address the recurring drainage problem.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Geromo and duly seconded by Honorable Uy, the Sangguniang Bayan of Molave, Zamboanga del Sur, hereby;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to respectfully request Engr. Pablo L. Escudro, MPA, District Engineer of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DWPH), 1st District Engineering Office, Rizal Avenue, Balangasan District, Pagadian City to conduct an immediate technical assessment and implement the necessary corrective measures on the drainage system along the Petron-Seaoil section of the national road in the Municipality of Molave, Zamboanga del Sur, to address the recurring ponding of rainwater and ensure the unobstructed flow of surface runoff for the protection of public safety and welfare.

UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED, this 24th day of June, 2026 at Barangay Alicia, Molave, Zamboanga del Sur.

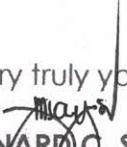

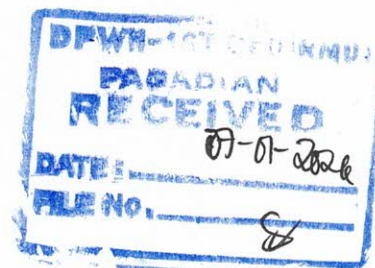
